“Vineyards across California each have their own influence on this poignant white. The tropical aromas of kiwi meld with the varietally iconic scent of white grapefruit; jasmine aromas lace between pine nut sweetness. From Monterey County AVA to Lake County, Napa and Sonoma and the warmer Happy Canyon AVA of Santa Barbara, all have a hand in citrus, minerality, vibrancy and depth of character. This is a stunning white, with a textural glistening across the mouth that tastes of ripe pineapple and lemon custard.

The acidity lifts the liquid up to a dignified presence.”
